READING COMPREHENSION

- DON'T FORGET THE TIME IS RUNNING.
- READ THE QUESTIONS AND THE DIFFERENT OPTIONS FOR ANSWERING BEFORE READING.
- BE QUIET TO GET CONCENTRATION IN THE READING.
- BE AWARE IN THOSE UNFAMILIAR TERMS OR VOCABULARY AND ENLIST THEM TO FIND THEIR MEANING.
- WRITE SOME IDEAS ABOUT THE CHARACTERS.
- MAKE DIAGRAMS, MIND MAPS, WRITING BLOCKS OR CHARTS TO CLASIFY THE MAIN IDEAS.
- CATHING DETAILS SUCH AS NAMES, PLACES, DATES, ETC.
- TAKE NOTES TO SAVE TIME.
- READ AGAIN IF YOU HAVE TIME.

ACTIVE LISTENING

- DON'T FORGET THE TIME IS RUNNING.
- READ THE QUESTIONS AND THE DIFFERENT OPTIONS FOR ANSWERING BEFORE LISTENING.
- BE QUIET TO LISTEN CAREFULLY WORD BY WORD.
- TAKE NOTES.
- CATCHING FAMILIAR WORDS.
- PAY ATTENTION IN PEOPLE, PLACES, NAMES, ETC.
- IDENTIFY WHO IS TALKING IN FIRST OR SECOND TURN, WHO AND WHAT ASK, WHO AND WHAT ANSWER.
- IDENTIFY WHAT IS THE ISSUE, SITUATION OR CIRCUNSTANCES FOR THAT CONVERATION.
- USE YOUR COMMON SENSE TO GUESS THE TOPIC.
- USE HEADPHONES.
- USE A PIECE OF PAPER.
- REPEAT AGAIN IF YOU HAVE TIME.
