Supporting sentences in an academic paragraph




After identifying a topic sentence, the next step is to support it with additional sentences that explain and elaborate on the **main idea**. These supporting sentences should provide **reasons** (the "whys"), and or the methods (the "hows") related to the topic sentence. Essentially, they need to offer clear **explanations**, **citations**, **examples**, and **details** that help the reader understand the main point of the paragraph, the topic sentence. If the ideas are not well-developed, the reader may struggle to grasp the writer's message, leading to confusion and a loss of interest in the text. In summary, supporting sentences play a crucial role in effectively conveying the central idea of the paragraph.




The almost finished paragraph from above is represented into a graphic organizer for a better understanding.
