

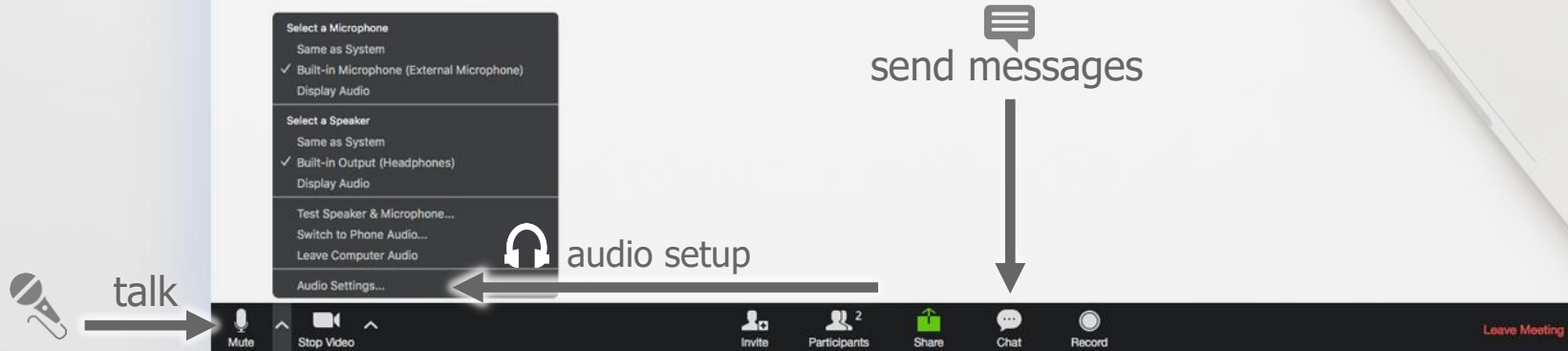

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## On:

Generally used for talking about a surface.

Ex. *The books are on the table.*

*The cup is on the saucer.*



on

## For:

Has many uses, but one use is to indicate time or duration.

Ex. *The cruise is for one week.*

*I am visiting France for two months.*



for

## In:

Generally used when talking about an enclosed space .

Ex. *I work in an office.*

*The books are in the library.*
