Generally used for talking about a surface.

Ex. The books are on the table. The cup is on the saucer.

#### For:

Has many uses, but one use is to indicate time or duration.

Ex. The cruise is for one week. I am visiting France for two months.

#### ln:

Generally used when talking about an enclosed space .

Ex. I work in an office. The books are in the library.








