<i>General (30 sec)</i>	<i>What kind of image is: photo, drawing, painting, etc.</i> <i>General idea: This picture makes me think about...</i> <i>Background</i> <i>Foreground</i> <i>On the left/right side</i> <i>In the middle</i>
<i>Specific details (60 -90 sec)</i>	<i>People (number, how many men and women, ages)</i> <i>Physical appearance (face, hair, eyes, nose, lips...)</i> <i>Facial expressions (mood)</i> <i>Clothes (kind of clothes, accessories, colors...)</i> <i>Actions (playing, hanging out, eating (food), exercising, studying, etc...)</i> <i>Place (environment, yard, field, classroom, park, buildings, pets, transportation, advertisements, billboards, etc.)</i> <i>Weather (sunny, raining, thunder, hot, snowy)</i>
<i>Inferences (30 sec)</i>	<i>How do they look like?</i> <i>What are they doing?</i> <i>Comparisons</i> <i>Culture</i> <i>Realities</i> <i>*Not to infer a lot. It makes the description arbitrary and it does not focus on the description</i>

*Inferences are important but not as much necessary as the main description of the picture.

You don't have to use inferences always at the end. You can use them while you describe.

*The most important resources in describing are the use of vocabulary, prepositions, modals, phrases to express opinion, idioms and specially CONNECTORS.

**When you talk, be sure of stay focused on the description and be careful on the time.
