Reading Comprehension and Grammar Focus

Objective:

- Improve students' reading comprehension with tourism-related texts.
- Teach and practice Past Continuous and Future Perfect Continuous grammar structures.

1. Introduction (5 minutes)

- Briefly introduce the class topics: healthy eating benefits vs. fast food, and transportation/travel planning in eastern Ecuador.
- State that the class will also focus on practicing Past Continuous and Future Perfect Continuous.

1st Reading Comprehension Activity (15 minutes)

Topic: The Benefits of Eating Healthy vs. Typical Fast Food Dishes in the USA

Reading Passage (excerpt, simplified):

Eating healthy provides a variety of benefits, including better energy levels and a reduced risk of diseases. Many people choose balanced diets that include fruits, vegetables, whole grains, and lean proteins. On the other hand, typical fast food dishes in the USA, such as hamburgers, hot dogs, and fried chicken, are high in calories and low in nutrients. Last year, many families were visiting fast food chains during busy days when they did not have time to cook meals at home. By next year, researchers will have been studying the long-term effects of fast food on health for decades.

Comprehension Questions:

- 1. What are two benefits of eating healthy mentioned in the passage?
- 2. Name three typical fast food dishes in the USA.
- 3. Why did families visit fast food chains last year?
- 4. What will researchers have been doing by next year?

Grammar Teaching Section (10 minutes)

Focus:

1. Past Continuous

- *Structure*: Subject + was/were + verb-ing
- Examples: "Many families were visiting fast food chains."
- Usage: Describes actions that were ongoing in the past.

2. Future Perfect Continuous

- *Structure*: Subject + will have been + verb-ing
- Examples: "By next year, researchers will have been studying."
- Usage: Describes actions that will continue up to a point in the future.

2nd Reading Comprehension Activity (15 minutes)

Topic: *Transportation Used to Travel in Ecuador & Planning a Trip to Eastern Ecuador*

Reading Passage (excerpt, simplified):

Ecuador offers diverse transportation options for travelers. People often use buses, private shuttles, or domestic flights to explore the country. While tourists were traveling in eastern Ecuador last year, they often saw breathtaking views of the Amazon rainforest. For trip planning, tourists should consider transportation services, like guided tours or boat rides, to reach remote areas. By the end of the month, many tourism companies will have been offering new transportation services for a year to improve travel experiences.

Comprehension Questions:

- 1. What transportation options are commonly used to travel in Ecuador?
- 2. What did tourists see while they were traveling in eastern Ecuador last year?
- 3. What transportation services should tourists consider for remote areas?
- 4. By the end of the month, what will tourism companies have been doing for a year?
