



- Page How to Write a Movie Review
- **✓** 1. Start with the Basics
- Write the basic information about the movie:
- **Title**: What is the name of the movie?
- **Year**: When was it made?
- **Genre**: What kind of movie is it? (Action, Comedy, Drama, etc.)
- **Main actors**: Who is in it?
- Example:

Title: *Toy Story*

Year: 1995

Genre: Animation / Adventure

Main actors: Tom Hanks, Tim Allen



2. Say What It's About (Plot)

• Write sentences about the story. Use **present simple**.

Example:

The movie is about toys that come to life when people are not looking.

Woody is a cowboy toy who feels jealous when a new toy, Buzz Lightyear, arrives.



✓ 3. Give Your Opinion

- Say what you **liked** or **didn't like**. Use simple adjectives like:
- fun / boring
- interesting / confusing
- exciting / slow
- funny / scary
- good / bad

Example:

I really liked the movie. It was funny and exciting. The animation was very good.



4. Recommend or Not?

• Finish with your opinion:

Do you recommend it? Who should watch it?

Example:

I recommend this movie for children and families.

It's a great movie for all ages.



Example Movie Review (Simple)

Title: Finding Nemo

Year: 2003

Genre: Animation, Adventure

Main Actors: Albert Brooks, Ellen DeGeneres

Plot:

The movie is about a fish named Marlin who looks for his son, Nemo. Nemo gets lost in the ocean, and Marlin travels a long way to find him.

Opinion:

I like the movie because it is funny and emotional.

The characters are interesting, and the animation is beautiful.

Recommendation:

I recommend this movie for kids and adults.

It is a great movie for the whole family.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE REVIEW

- Write a review of the movie watched in class
- Use around 200–220 words.
- The review is **personal**, so **don't copy** others' work. (classmate or internet)
- Please include the following:

Basic Information

- Title of the movie
- Year of release
- Type of movie (action, comedy, drama, etc.)
- Main actors

2. Summary of the Story (no spoilers)

- What is the movie about?
- Where and when does the story happen?
- Who are the main characters?

3. Your Personal Opinion

- Did you like the movie? Why or why not?
- What was your favorite part?
- What did you enjoy the most (acting, music, story, special effects...)?

4. Final Recommendation

- Do you recommend this movie? Why?
- Who is it good for? (kids, teenagers, adults, families...) Explain

P Tips:

- Use simple connectors: and, but, because, also, then
- Use easy adjectives: **funny**, **boring**, **exciting**, **sad**, **beautiful**, **long**, **good**
- Use the **present simple** to describe the story
- You can use the **past simple** to share your experience

EXAMPLE

Movie Review: Spider-Man: Into the Spider-Verse (2018)

The story shows that anyone can be a hero if they believe in themselves. It also talks about friendship, family, and doing the right thing.
